You have been referred to the Community Diversion Program. We hope that this experience will be a positive one! To help you get started we have enclosed some paperwork, questionnaires and other forms that we are asking you to complete prior to your intake appointment at our office. Please bring these forms with you to your scheduled appointment on _____. If you have questions about these forms, please feel free to call our office, as someone will be happy to assist you.

About us:

- We are a small, independent, non-profit organization located in Greenland, NH.
- We work with youth ages 11-18 by helping them reflect on their personal decision making.
- We offer psycho-educational classes and support with community service hours.
- No child is ever denied services based on ability to pay.

About the diversion process:

- An intake appointment is required before working on your diversion contract/court orders. This meeting generally lasts one hour – and consists of some paper work and a questionnaire.
- During the intake meeting we will discuss when to come back to CDP for classes and programming, deadlines and expectations.
- After the intake meeting, when necessary and with your permission, we notify your referral source (e.g. probation, police, school) that you have participated in this meeting.
- Once you have fulfilled your contract by attending classes, taking part in special programs, or by performing community service hours (and we have all the necessary documentation) your case will be closed and the referral source notified.

We look forward to working with you – and will see you at your intake appointment!
